- 1 The Company addresses the consumer location based services market as well as enterprise and infrastructure space.
- 2 The Company operates only in single Primary Segment i.e. Geographical Information Systems.
- 3 The financial results for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2015 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and thereafter, the Board of Directors at its meeting held on May 30, 2015 approved the same and its release.
- 4 The Board of Directors have recommended, subject to the approval of shareholders, a dividend of 2.5% i.e. Re. 0.125 per fully paid up equity share of Rs. 5 each aggregating to Rs. 38.06 lacs. (Previous Year Re. 0.125 per equity share aggregating to Rs. 37.31 lacs)
- 5 Effective April 1, 2014, the Company has revised the useful life of fixed assets based on Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013 for the purpose of providing depreciation on fixed assets. Accordingly, the carrying amount of the assets as on April 1, 2014 has been depreciated over the remaining revised useful life of the fixed assets. Consequently an amount of Re 45.26 lakhs (net off deferred tax) representing the carrying amount of the assets with revised useful life as Nil, has been charged to the opening reserves as on April 1, 2014 pursuant to the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013.
- 6 During the quarter and year ended March 31, 2015, the Company has allotted 6,00,000 equity shares of Rs. 5 each to M/s Aeries India private Limited, arising from the conversion of 6,00,000 Warrants.
- 7 Figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2015 and March 31, 2014 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the published year to date figures up to the third quarter of the relevant financial year.
